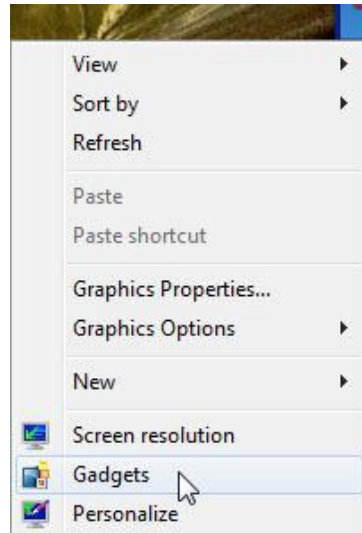


# Lesson 11\_Gadgets on Windows 7 Desktop

Add gadgets:

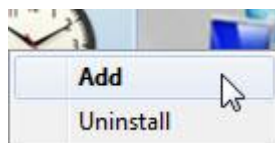
1. Right click at blank spot on desktop. You will see the following menu box. Look for Gadgets.



2. Click at Gadgets. Look for **Clock**.

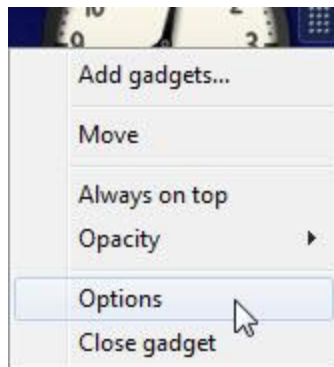


3. Right Click on **Clock**. Look for **Add**. Click on **Add**. An analogue clock should show up at right upper corner of the desktop.

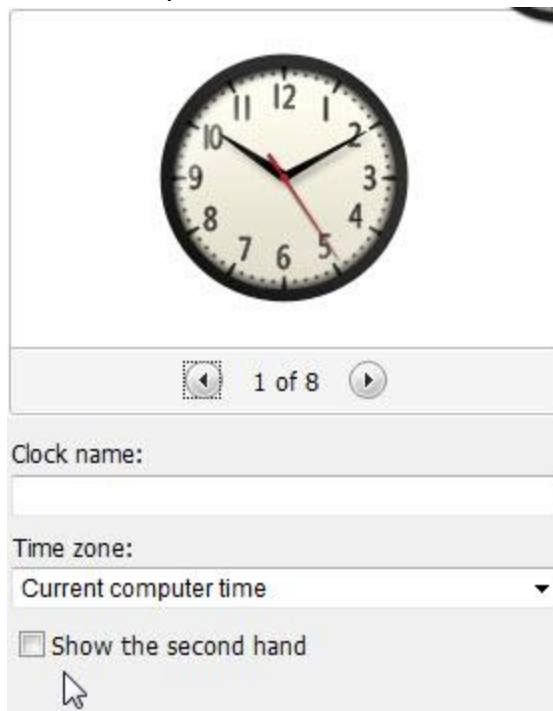

4. If you like the clock showing its "second hand", follow these steps:
  - i. Right click at the clock. Look for "Options".



- ii. Click on "Options".



- iii. Check **Show the second hand**. Then click **OK**. You should see the clock has a second hand now.
  - iv. In the box shown at step ii, you can choose different appearance of the clock if you like to do so.
  - v. You can choose more gadgets shown in step 2 by following the same procedure.

Please add **Calendar** and **CPU Meter** as your home work.

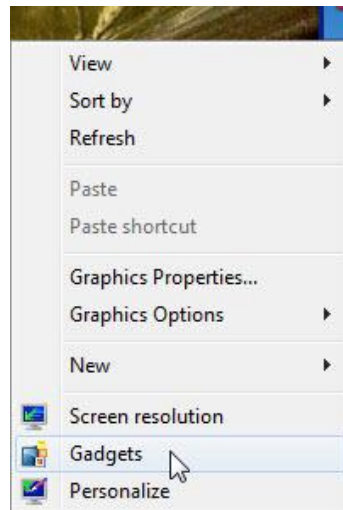

Download gadgets from Internet:

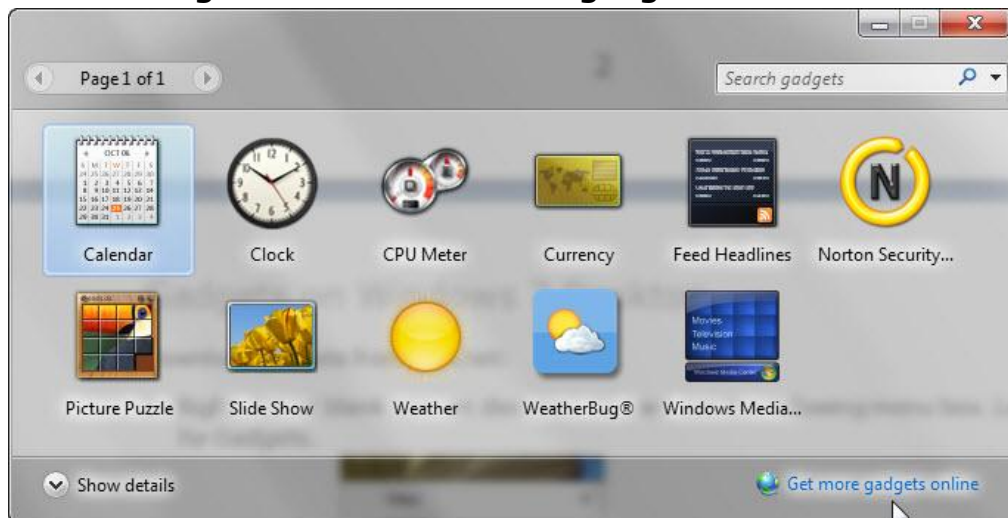
1. Create a folder, named **Gadgets**, under **Downloads** which is under your computer user name folder.

The path is: Computer\Local Disk(C:)\Users\Your Name\Downloads

- a. Double click on the **Computer** icon on the desktop.
  - b. Double click on **Local Disk(C:)**.
  - c. Double click on **Users**.
  - d. Double click on **Your Name**.
  - e. Double click on **Downloads**.
  - f. Right click, choose **New, Folder** and type **Gadgets**.
2. Right click at blank spot on desktop. You will see the following menu box. Look for **Gadgets**.



3. Click on **Gadgets**. Look for **Get more gadgets online** and click on it.

4. A Microsoft webpage will show up with many gadgets on it. Look for **WeatherBug** and click on it. You will see another webpage shown up.
5. Click on **Download**. Then click on **Install**.

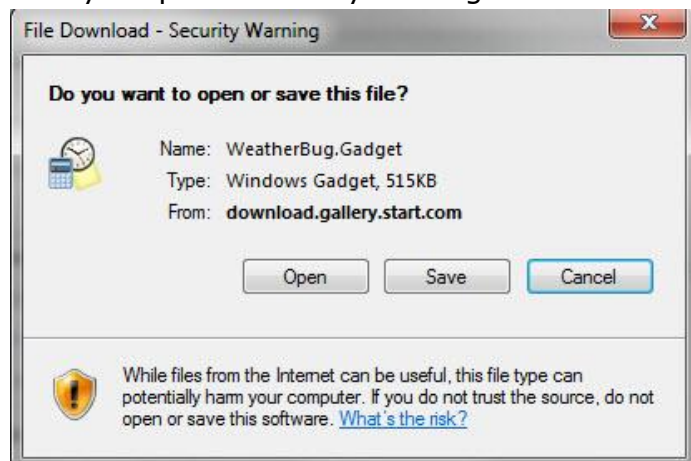
